

About Raphah Ministries

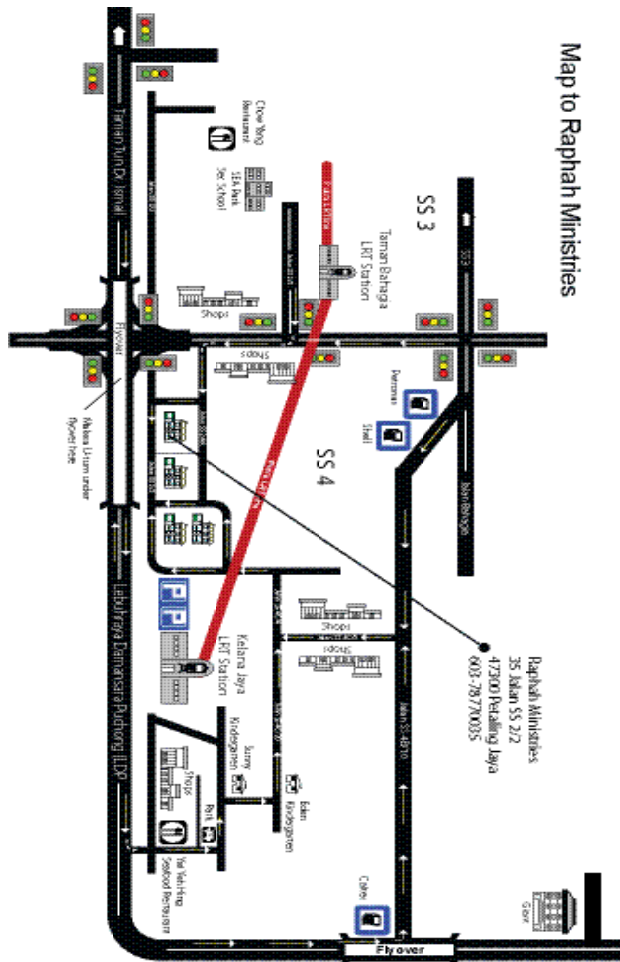
Raphah Ministries is a non-denominational Christian healing and discipleship ministry with a vision to touch hurting and wounded believers with the Father-Heart of God, and to rebuild such broken lives with healing and restoration to wholeness through the Word of God, biblical counsel and Spirit-enabled prayer.

The ministry had its beginnings in a local prayer support group for the Ellel Ministries' International Schools of Evangelism, Healing and Discipleship, England, and grew out of the desire of a number of its alumni to establish a similar local ministry and training centre where believers could come and receive teaching, be trained and equipped to serve the Body of Christ in healing and discipleship ministry.

Based at "Beit Raphah" – House of Healing – located in the residential suburb of Petaling Jaya, Raphah Ministries is served by volunteer ministry teams and a Leadership comprising members from different congregations. The Leadership is in turn advised by a panel of senior Christian leaders of the Malaysian Church community.

The ministry is registered in Malaysia as Life Rebuilders (M) Sdn. Bhd. [534687-U] and has training and ministry centres in Petaling Jaya and Ipoh.

Raphah Ministries is a current member of the National Evangelical Christian Fellowship of Malaysia (NECF).

About the Seminar

Life can be very unpredictable and traumatic. During the course of our lives, many of us will be touched and affected by dramatic, life-altering events: a disabling accident; the loss of a job or business; failure of a relationship; breakdown in marriage; divorce. Not least of these dramatic events is the loss of a loved one, whether expected or unexpected.

Grief is a natural and valid response to the loss of someone or something of value. At the same time, it is a natural process that can easily be misinterpreted or misunderstood.

As a response to personal loss, grief can vary from person to person. Even so, any significant loss can throw a person into emotional turmoil or dysfunction, resulting in some cases in prolonged distress.

Such unresolved, prolonged grief can open the door to spiritual, emotional and physical problems that potentially can paralyze a person's well-being and spiritual development.

The loss of a loved one—especially through death—is a particularly major trauma for most people. Therefore, it is important for us—while we have the opportunity—to know and understand how to handle grief and bereavement when they touch us, and how to support and minister to others who have been touched likewise.

This seminar provides helpful insights and understanding into the journey through grief and beyond. It begins by examining loss as a normal part of life, and how different people respond to such loss. This is followed by a walk through the grief process and its different aspects before concluding with God's words of truth and comfort.

The teaching on the seminar is usually accompanied by a time of prayer into some of the areas covered in the seminar.
