Based at "Beit Raphah" - House of Healing - located in the residential suburb of Petaling Jaya, Raphah Ministries is served by volunteer ministry teams and a Leadership comprising members from different congregations. The Leadership is in turn advised by a panel of senior Christian leaders of the Malaysian Church community.

The ministry is registered in Malaysia as Life Rebuilders (M) Sdn. Bhd. [534687-U] and has training and ministry centres in Petaling Jaya and Ipoh.

Raphah Ministries is a current member of the National Evangelical Christian Fellowship of Malaysia (NECF).

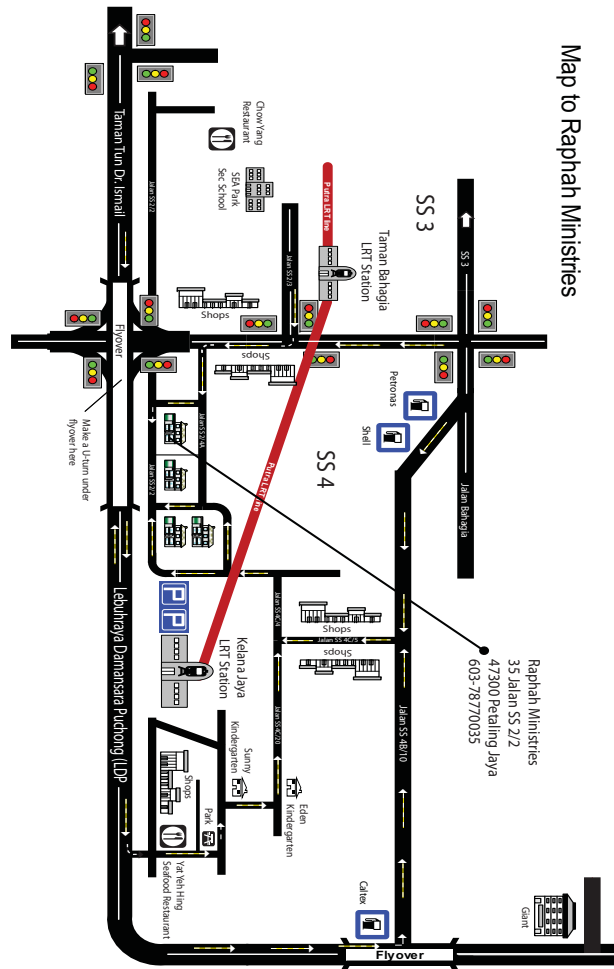

About the Seminar

The Lord's Prayer is the most recited prayer since its inception, from the time of our Lord Jesus until today. Practically each week in most traditional churches, the whole congregation is invited to pray this prayer corporately. Even "Alcoholics Anonymous" end their sessions with the reciting of this prayer.

But do the people understand the content of what they are reciting? Is it like a mantra that when recited evokes a pleasant effect on the pray-er? Or do worshippers recite the prayer just so that they get the feeling that they have been blessed each time they do so?

In Luke 11:1, one of the disciples made this request, "Lord, teach us how to pray." Jesus' reply to his request can be found in Matthew 6:9, "This, then, is how you should pray..."

This seminar helps us to get a better understanding of the content of the prayer that our Lord Jesus taught His disciples.

There are elements of praise and worship of God at the beginning of the prayer. There is petition, confession and forgiveness, protection against evil and a refocus on God the Father, who is eternal.

William Barclay made this comment: "The fact that Jesus taught all men to pray this prayer shows the universality of sin." It helps us to maintain a proper perspective as to who we are in relation to the Almighty God, our Creator and Father.
