

Course Description

This 4-day Course (Part 2) is a skills- and practice-oriented component in healing ministry, designed to build on and complement the **Understanding Christian Healing: The Issues** 6-day Course (Part 1) conducted by Raphah Ministries.

Over the four days participants are given further biblical teaching on the practice of Christian healing ministry, tested and practical ministry insights, diagnostic tools, vital keys to healing, and guidelines for praying healing and restoration into individuals confronted with specific physical, psychological and spiritual needs.

Participants intending to register for this Course are required to have first completed the 6-day **Understanding Christian Healing: The Issues** Short Course .

Both Part 1 and Part 2 are deliberately designed to give priority to learning how to listen to God in extending healing ministry, how to identify root problems and consequences, and how to develop appropriate responses so that ministry is led by the Holy Spirit according to an individual's circumstances and needs.

Teaching Format

The daily schedule consists of three or four teaching sessions with regular breaks, and includes times for discussion, questions and answers, as well as prayer as led by the Spirit of God.

Attendance at all training sessions over the 4 days is required, and on completion of the Course, participants will receive a **Certificate of Attendance**.

About Raphah Ministries

The Ministry is headed by a Leadership Team comprising pastors and lay persons from different local congregations, and is in turn advised by a panel of senior Christian leaders of the Malaysian Christian community.

Raphah Ministries is an active member of the National Evangelical Christian Fellowship (NECF) and is registered in Malaysia as **Life Rebuilders (M) Sdn. Bhd.** with its Centre in Petaling Jaya, Selangor.
